

Case Study: Mail Sorter Security

Client: College of Nursing in a State University

Problem:

- Tampering with mail is a federal offense, and no matter how in-depth the screening, hiring honest employees can be a difficult task.
- Although the front of mailboxes are locked and secured, the back of mail sorters usually remain open and vulnerable to theft of personal and financial information.







Solution:

- Lockable rolling doors limit access to designated security personnel, providing a tighter reign on mail distribution.
- When Rollok doors are closed and locked, personal financial information is protected from identity theft and criminal misuse.
- Unlike swinging or sliding doors which create obstructions, these doors roll up into housing to allow full access to the mail sorter area.
